Thus, volunteers are necessary to supplement the local public health response to, and recovery from, emergency disasters.

The Clayton County Public Health District, PHVIP Orientation consists of a 4.5 hour course to include administrative procedures. The course is part of the process for citizens, and medical and non-medical professionals to become members of District 3-3 PHVIP volunteer Unit.
